TEPHINET

- Only global network of 75 member programs training field epidemiologists in more than 100 countries; member programs also include those with laboratory and veterinarian education components.
- FETP accreditation, grant mechanisms (e.g. NCD Small Grant) TEPHICConnect, establish/support development of FETP program

SPC

- Pacific Public Health Surveillance Network (PPHSN) - core Members of 22 Pacific MOHs, supported by allied bodies (training institutions, networks/associations, international agencies, etc); members from core members and allied bodies made up a Coordinating Body with SPC as the focal point.
- Strengthening Health Interventions in the Pacific - Data for Decision Making (SHIPDDM) programme, PPHSN Pacific Syndromic Surveillance System, PICNet, EpiNet, LabNet, PacNet

ANU
