- ♥ One person can submit only one manuscript.
- The participant must be willing to change the contents in the manuscript as per comments in the workshop.
- Speople who have been trained in our previous scientific writing workshops will not be eligible for the scholarships.





Guidelines for the Draft Manuscript

- * A cover letter with the corresponding author's full contact details should be provided.
- * The draft manuscript must be typed in Times New Roman, font size 12, with single spacing.
- * Abstract should clearly state objective(s), methods, data analyses, results and conclusion.
- * Abstract should not exceed 350 words.
- * Main topics of the draft manuscript must include introduction, methods, results with tables and figures, discussion, conclusion, recommendations and references.
- * The texts in manuscript should not exceed 3,000 words.
- * Information included in the manuscript has not been published in any local or international journal before.
